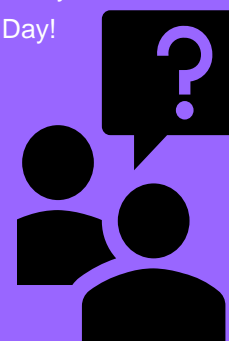

Spring is the perfect time to make a bird feeder, decorate the sidewalk with chalk drawings, plant flowers or even make some home-made bubbles! Use the instructions below and have some fun!

Remember, activities are always better with a buddy or a parent...be sure to ask for help if you need it.

**Make Bird Feeders**  
 Mix unflavored gelatin as directed on the box and stir in some bird seed. It should be thick, but sticky. Press the mixture into silicone molds or cookie cutters. Stick a loop of string in each feeder. Allow to harden. Hang outside.

**MAKE BUBBLES!**  
 2/3 Cup Dishwashing Soap    1 Gal Water    2-3 Tbsp Glycerin  
 Mix together and pour into a shallow pan or refill an old bubble bottle.  
 Add 1-2 drops food colong for colorful bubbly fun!
