

Tomorrow (May 21<sup>st</sup>) is the BIG day ... West Farm Pool opens! We invite the community out to enjoy some cool waters and warm sun.

Don't forget that Larrio's Doggie Wagon will be in the pool parking lot from 12-3pm. While relaxing in the sun be sure to grab a snack or some lunch.

Pool operating hours are: 7:00am – 9:00pm (or until dusk, whichever is first)

Hours of 7:00am – 9:00am are reserved for adult swim only, please.

A few reminders for a safe and fun pool season:

- 1) **Caution Sign** ... the Board is aware there is some pool edging that has begun to breakdown. Repairs this Spring would have resulted in delayed opening of the pool, and would have been a significant financial impact that we preferred to plan for. For these reasons, the Board chose to delay the repairs until end of 2022 or early 2023. Major damage area is marked with caution tape, please avoid climbing in and out of pool at this spot.
- 2) Swim at your own Risk ... we do not have lifeguards on duty, so swimming is at your own risk. We suggest that you never swim alone, and you stay in depth that is comfortable for your swim ability. All children under 14 must have an adult with them while swimming.
- 3) No Animals ... Pets are not allowed inside the pool fenced area at any time.
- **4) No loud / profane music ...** Be respectful of your neighbors and do not play music loudly or that has profane language. (There are always children around the pool with sensitive ears).
- 5) Smoking & Vaping is prohibited ... no tobacco related products are allowed inside fence area.
- 6) No Glass ... please do not bring glass containers into the pool fence area including the picnic area.
- 7) Children under 3 years of age ... swim diapers or rubber diaper swim cover is required. Diapers are not to be pool area trash bins; please take these with you and dispose at your home.
